# **Mērkis**

Rosinošā un patīkamā veidā iepazīstināt bērnus vecumā no 6-7 gadu vecuma ar angļu valodu kā svešvalodu, kā arī attīstīt bērnos vēlmi apgūt angļu valodu arī turpmāk.

#### Uzdevumi

- 1. Attīstīt bērnos klausīšanās un runāšanas prasmes angļu valodā. Šī kursa laikā bērniem nav vajadzība ne lasīt, ne rakstīt.
- Nodrošināt bērnus ar noderīgu un praktisku vārdu krājumu, kas ļaus vienkāršā veidā sazināties ar angliski runājošiem.
   Mērķtiecīgi un regulāri atkārtot jau apgūto vielu, tādējādi nostiprinot zināšanas.
   Nodrošināt bērniem drošu un patīkamu mācību vidi angļu valodas stundās.

# Mācību satura apguvei izmantojamās metodes un metodiskie paņēmieni

Apmācība notiek grupās, pāros un individuāli, caur valodas prasmju attīstošām spēlēm, dziesmām, stāstiem un katra bērna vecuma posma īpatnībām tiek piemēroti atbilstoši mācību materiāli, grāmatas. Šis kurs nodrošina bērnus ar ikdienā dzirdamu angļu valodu un izteicieniem caur stāstiem, ilustrācijām, skaņām un intonāciju. Tādējādi bērniem ir viegli saprast stāstus, pat ja viņi neatpazīst visus vārdus.

### Paredzamie rezultāti

Dalībnieki apgūs bērna interesēm atbilstošu iesākuma vardu krājumu. Spēs saprast dzirdēto, ka arī ar vienkāršiem vārdiem, teikumiem un frāzēm sākt sazināties ar apkārtējiem angļu valodā.
